Your main tasks are:

1. Finish your ONCE story.
2. Complete the Reading tasks in the Reading folder- there are lots of passages to choose from which you should read and answer the questions.
3. Work on some of the Grammar tasks in the LANGUAGE folder. Take your pick! There are some bigger booklets too to work through.
4. Read a book for at least 20minutes a day. Once you get through your book you should work on the BOOK PRESENTATION task which is in your READING FOLDER.

Alternative activities

1. READ, READ, READ!! Or LISTEN, LISTEN, LISTEN to any free books or newspapers, comics, magazines you can find.
2. Try reading to someone at home- a younger sibling perhaps?
3. Keep a diary of this time- record your feelings every day and describe them in detail using language techniques.
4. If you can access Iplayer try to find some good quality documentaries on topics which you would like to learn more about- perhaps you can find some about World War 2 or the Holocaust? I would recommend using CBBC or BBC3 with your parent's/carer permission
